

PBS and RPBS Authorities – Health Professional Online Service (HPOS) Form Upload

When submitting a PBS or RPBS authority application via the HPOS Form Upload, it is important that you select the correct Form Category and Form Type.

Selecting the appropriate Form Category and Form Type will ensure your application is sent to the correct agency, allowing for a smoother assessment process avoiding any unnecessary delays.

Note: To assist with processing, ensure you include the patient's DVA file number with all DVA RPBS applications.

It is important to remember that only yourself or your delegate/s are authorised to submit PBS & RPBS authority applications via the HPOS Form Upload.

Make sure you've:

- linked your prescriber number to your Provider Digital Access (PRODA) account for HPOS; and
- Set up your delegations in HPOS.

We understand having access to PBS-subsidised medicines can be critical to patient care. That's why Services Australia and the Department of Health, Disability and Ageing have been working together to increase the number of PBS medicines that can be requested and approved using the Online PBS Authorities system (the system).

PBS Authority requests made online provide immediate, real-time assessment outcomes, or in some instances, a full/delayed assessment where the authority request is digitally submitted to a Service Australia operator for assessment.
